



General Protocol for Chiropractic on Horses:

1. Horse must be groomed free of mud, dirt and manure prior to the chiropractic evaluation.
2. Depending on the condition of your horse, Dr. Frick might recommend therapy be used which could include heat, ultrasound, microcurrent, or laser.
3. After therapy and adjustments, the following is recommended:
 - *No riding for two days. Pasture or paddock exercise is good.
 - *Light exercise on day three.
 - *Resume regular routine on day four.
4. Do not vaccinate within two weeks of chiropractic adjustments.
5. Call if you have concerns.
6. Payment is expected when services are rendered.

If you are hauling your horse to Animal Fitness Center:

1. Bring a blanket in cold weather to put on for the trip home.
2. Please pull through the **open gate** adjacent to the Clinic and park between the barn and the Northside of the Clinic. **Do not pull into parking lot.**
